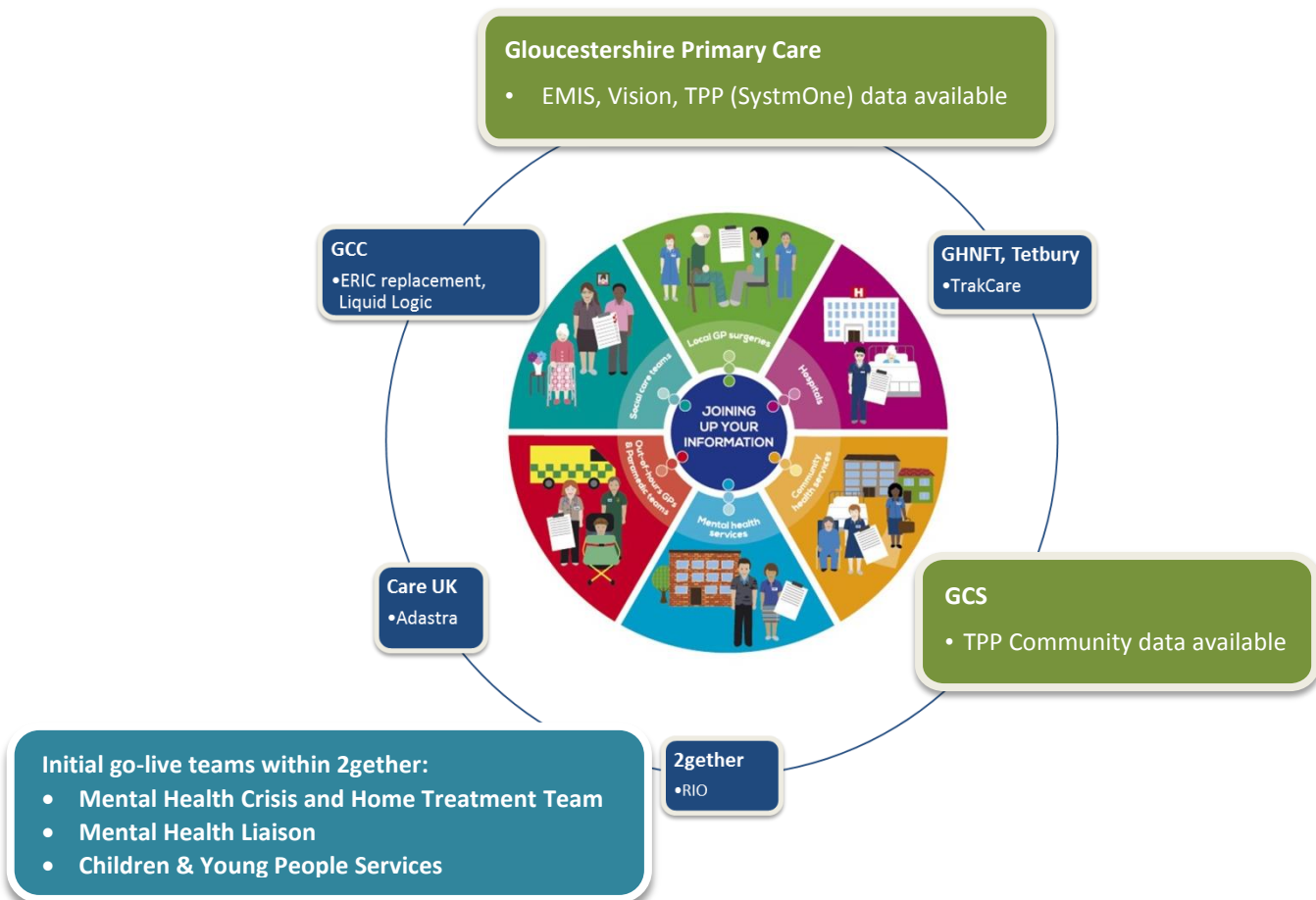


JUYI Partner Update – June 2018

JUYI is making progress and is now in the user acceptance testing (UAT) phase, with the first round completed across all source systems, including functional testing and data validation.

Other activities taking place include updating all documents to reflect GDPR, completing all opt-out processing, finalising the JUYI Clinical Safety Case Report, patient engagement and creating an information pack for GP practices.

Phase 1 of JUYI covers seven different care providers using nine different systems across 18 urgent care services.



The first go-live will enable the 2gether urgent care teams:

- **Mental Health Crisis and Home Treatment Team**
- **Mental Health Liaison**
- **Children & Young People Services**

to click a tab within their source system (RiO) and view **Primary care** and **GCS TPP Community Care** data.

We have started meeting with these teams in preparation for the initial JUYI go live in the coming weeks.

The roll-out will be a gradual phased process, with further releases over 2018. These will enable more groups of users to access an increasing number of data sets using JUYI.

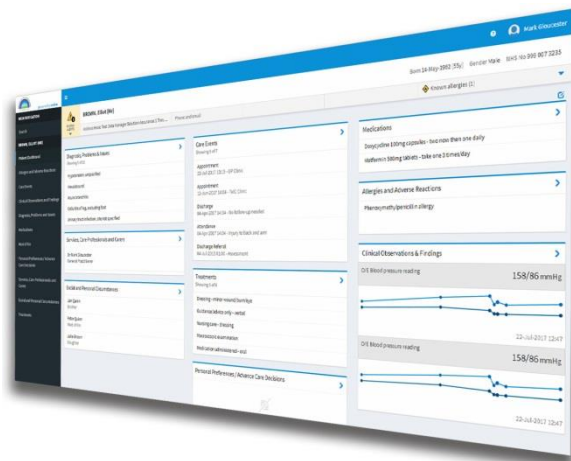
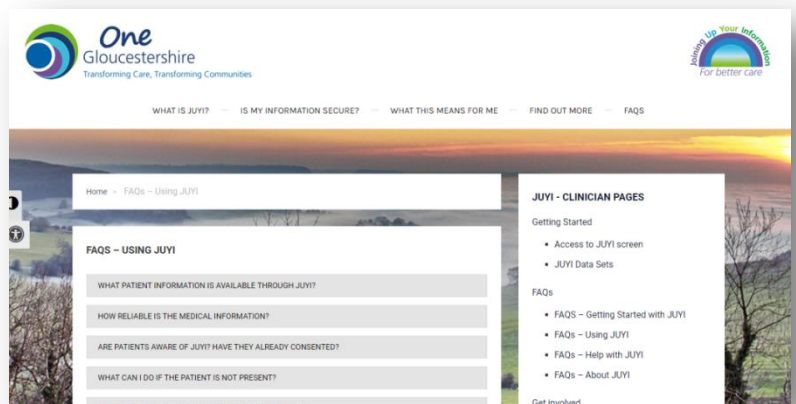
