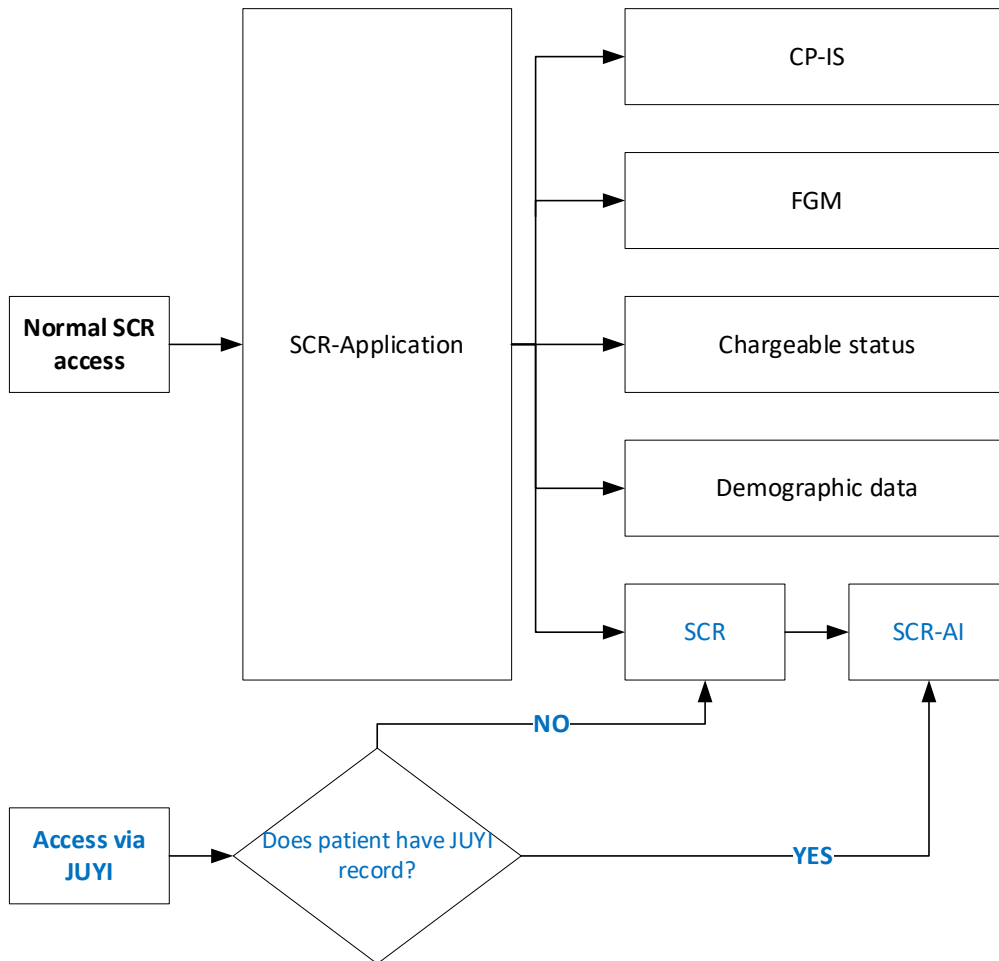

High Level JUYI/SCR Access


